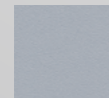

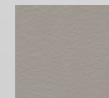
SYSTEM

This family of cutlery inserts is available in many drawer widths and fits all conventional frame systems. Despite its linear design, NICK can be stacked on top of each other in optimal fashion, and its reduced height of 50 mm also allows it to be used in shallow pull-out systems. The trend shades of grey in slate and anthracite lend themselves beautifully to creating a sophisticated yet unobtrusive look.

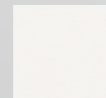
Alternatively, NICK is also available in many standard and customised colours. The elegance of the neutral shades is emphasised by translucent acrylic partitions, whereby these variable elements can be inserted to divide up the large outer compartment in draw widths from 60 cm.



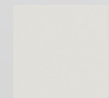

STRIKING LINEAR DESIGN & A GOOD IDEA

The special feature of NICK is the angled bottom of the compartments. The subtle ridge created in this manner ideally fits to the shape of the flatware, and the contents of the drawer are less prone to slipping and rattling when the drawer is opened.

The interior of the drawer is put to good use with NICK. The narrow partitions enable two compartments to be arranged behind each other so that knives, forks and spoons in two different lengths can be stored there. Everything is beautifully and systematically organised.
